The goal is address knowing where to start, knowing the person you support, and how to get resources. It will discuss how to use positive behavior support techniques, alongside Applied Behavior Analysis, in order to decide on interventions for the specific person they are working with. Included will be discussion about common misconceptions, thinking errors on the part of the support team, and how some good intentioned interventions, without the proper education, could actually be setting people up for failure. This training will also review risk and protective factors and how to safely and mindfully incorporate more protective interventions into planning.
