

## Medication Administration Training Course Guidance ODP Announcement 22-113

## **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this announcement is to provide guidance and a timeline for the implementation requirement of the 2022 Online Medication Administration Training Course and manual. Also, to announce the discontinuation of the 2004 paper course and paper examinations on **January 1, 2024.** 

## **DISCUSSION:**

All Medication Administration trainers are now required to take the new 2022 online Medication Administration Training Course located at <u>medadmin.myodp.org</u>. Existing trainers, who have not been certified through the new course, are required to take the 2022 online course when their certification expires. Both new and existing trainers may continue to monitor students and practicum observers.

A webinar was held on Thursday, September 8th from 2:00 PM – 3:00 PM to provide an overview of how to request Student and Practicum Observer Classes in the New Medication Administration Training Course platform. The webinar reviewed how to request new student classes (including Practicum Observer classes), view grader reports of their students, how to mark exam remediation, and view student qualification
