

# Required Communication Specialist Provider Qualification Training

# **ODP Announcement 23-048 UPDATE**

### **AUDIENCE:**

Providers that render Communication Specialist services and Administrative Entities (AEs)

#### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this announcement is to remind Communication Specialist providers that in order to provide services after January 1, 2024, the Communication Specialist training must be completed.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

ODP added a new provider qualification to the Consolidated, Community Living, and Person/Family Directed Support(P/FDS) Waivers for Communication Specialist services. This is a direct and indirect service that supports participants with nontraditional communication needs.

All providers who wish to provide this service after January 1, 2024, **must complete the Communication Specialist training provided on MyODP**. This applies to Communication

Specialists, Communication Specialists that are direct employees of an agency, and contracted employees of an agency.
