### What does this look like in practice?



Communication is a two-way street. It isn't just about the words you use, but how you understand the words that other people use. Our personal experiences and relationships influence how we assign meaning to words. With so much diverse experience among people, of course misunderstandings happen every day! Ask more questions. Use LifeCourse tools like the trajectory to guide your discussions. Remember 'the swing' and make sure to check with each other often to see if you are on the same page.

#### **OSCAR'S STORY**

Hello. My name is Oscar Drummond, self-advocate. The trajectory has helped me in a lot of ways. I can do a lot more, have a lot more opportunities and see how far I have come. The trajectory can tell a lot about how we are going to get there (to my Vision) together. It makes clear I WANT to do these things AND I DON"T want to do these things. The challenge is that people don't always believe you can get the support you need. And you must have a team. It takes a whole TEAM, all together, to be successful. The trajectory helps bring new staff onboard and make sure they are involved. The tool helps everyone on the team be on the same page, see who is missing from the team and bring them onboard, too.
