<i>Updates reflect changes and clarifications made to the ISP Manual released on August 10, 2026.</i>	
14.2: Assistive Technology	Added clarification that administrative fees related to the purchase of off-the-shelf devices are not covered under Assistive Technology except through the OHCDs administrative service.
14.16: In-Home and Community Support Services Section 14.21: Respite	Added clarification outlined in ODP Announcement 24-086 when it is determined that 2:1 enhanced levels of service is needed in the VF/EA participant directed services model.
Section 14.18: Participant-Directed Goods and Services	Added clarification that Participant-Directed Goods and Services cannot be used for: • Staffing ratios that are not covered in other services. • Staff training for paid services because staff training is covered in the rate paid to providers. .
Section 14.20: Residential Services	Residential services can now be billed on the day of discharge from a nursing or rehabilitation facility. This replaces previous guidance that residential services could only be billed the day after discharge from a nursing or rehabilitation facility.
	Additional Service Definition Clarification has been added to the Supported Living service regarding when a provider can co-sign a lease with the individual.
Section 14.26: Supports Coordination	Added new procedure codes for Supports Coordination effective 1/1/2027 and guidance for the Initial Plan Development.

Section 15: Policy for Waiver Services Provided by Relatives, Legal Guardians and Legally Responsible Individuals	Aligned guidance with communications published regarding services provided by relatives, legal guardians and legally responsible individuals.
Section 16: Section 16: Service Delivery During Travel	Aligned guidance with communications published regarding participant directed service delivery during travel. Added clarification regarding service delivery during travel for traditional providers.
Section 17: Base-Funded Services	Added new procedure codes for base-funded Supports Coordination effective 1/1/2027.
Section 18: Targeted Support Management (TSM)	Added new procedure codes for Targeted Support Management effective 1/1/2027 and guidance for the Initial Plan Development/ Program Intake Assessment.
Section 21: General Billing Terms	Added terms for bi-annual, monthly unit and initial plan development/ Program Intake Assessment.
