Status Update: MyPBC Portal Submissions



Portal Usage Highlights

Below is a detailed update on MyPBC Portal usage as of 3/9, including a breakdown of submitted forms by tier:

Saving your work

- Portal does not auto-save - please save your work regularly using **Save & Continue** or **Save & Exit**
- If opening a section to review, avoid making edits in that section unless you plan to save

When multiple users are working in the same form

- Multiple users can support the same submission at the same time, but we recommend one person at a time actively updating a section.
- If you want to see recent activity, you can review the form history from the **MyPBC Profile** screen.

File uploads

- After clicking **Upload File**, wait for loading icon to stop and file name to appear, indicating a successful upload.
- Before moving on from sections with file uploads, confirm your upload is complete by checking that the filename appears in the form - delete icon will appear).

Final submission

- At the end of the form, complete the attestation and signature steps and select **Submit & Close**.

- **62 out of 101 providers that failed submitted resolution**

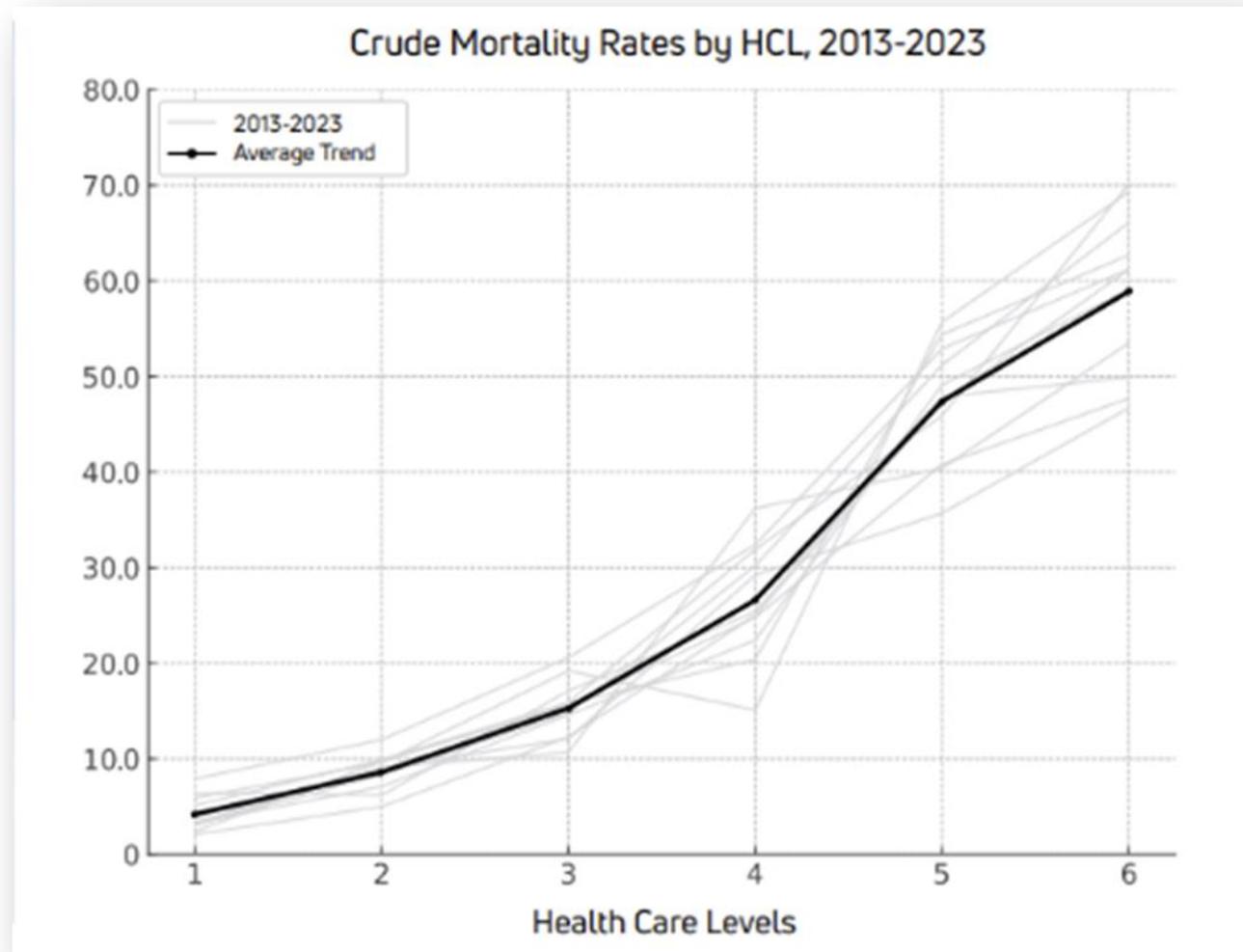


- **Credentialing**
 - SCOs that submitted: 44
 - SCOs that passed: 36
 - Total funding distributed: over \$1.75 million
- **Technology**
 - SCOs that submitted: 35
 - SCOs that passed: 31
 - Total funding distributed: over \$1.84 million
- **Milestone 2: achieve at least 1 of the 4 targets below**
 - Increase in Supported Employment Services AND CIE
 - Increase in % SL, LS, or HTTS
 - Increase in % Non-residential
 - Increase in RS or AT services



Current health risk screenings (HRS) in place for all individuals including applicable assessments as indicated by HRST protocol

- For 2026, the 2025 data for annual updates for this measure is based on the HRST last update to either the rating questions or to the Notes/Comment section of the tool. This is viewable via the **Record Activity with Provider** Standard Report under the HRST Last Updated Column. This report also provides information on Medication and Diagnoses entry dates. The standard report Total Incomplete Clinical Reviews Not Done 21 Days After Last Rating Update is used to identify timeliness of Clinical Reviews.
- For 2027, the 2026 data for this measure will be based that date of update for each of the 22 rating items' rating questions. All rating questions must be updated annually. The standard report **Record Activity with Provider** will inform the annual rating questions update, medication and diagnosis information. Clinical review timeliness will be measured based on process above.
- Why is this important?





- Attest to assist in efforts, beginning January 1, 2025, to support ODP data collection on family satisfaction with provider engagement
 - ODP will survey individuals and families to measure their satisfaction with family engagement. Measure will not be implemented until January 2025. Providers will fail this measure if there is no evidence of support.
- Ways to meet the measure
 - Response rate > 0%
 - Other evidence of distributed survey

Measure Review: QI.03.3 (cont.1)



157 out of 363 providers had a **response rate higher than 20%**

95 out of 363 providers had a **response rate lower than 10%**

35 providers distributed the survey but had **no response rate**

Unreported Incidents



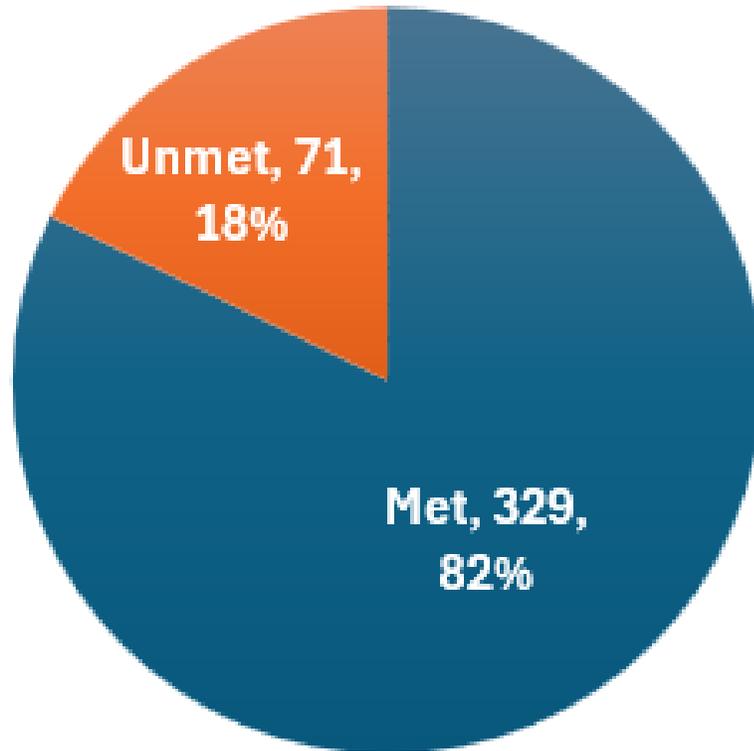

Note: ODP will apply an adjustment variable to the 1% threshold to account for partial year data being used.

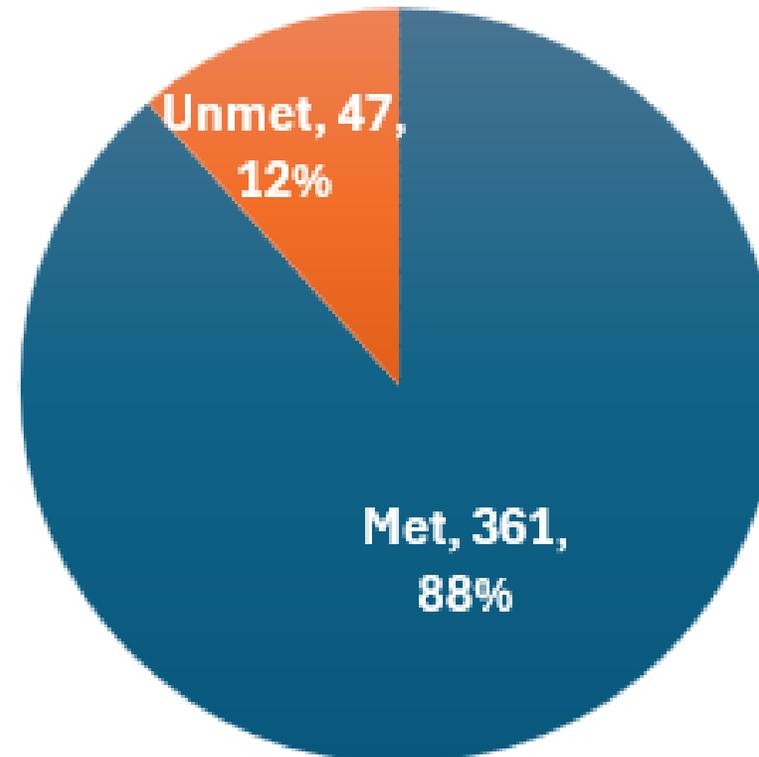

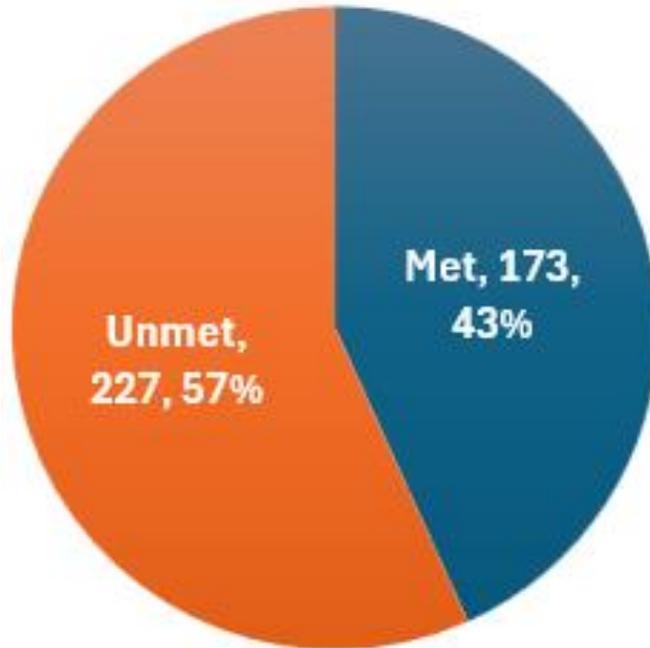

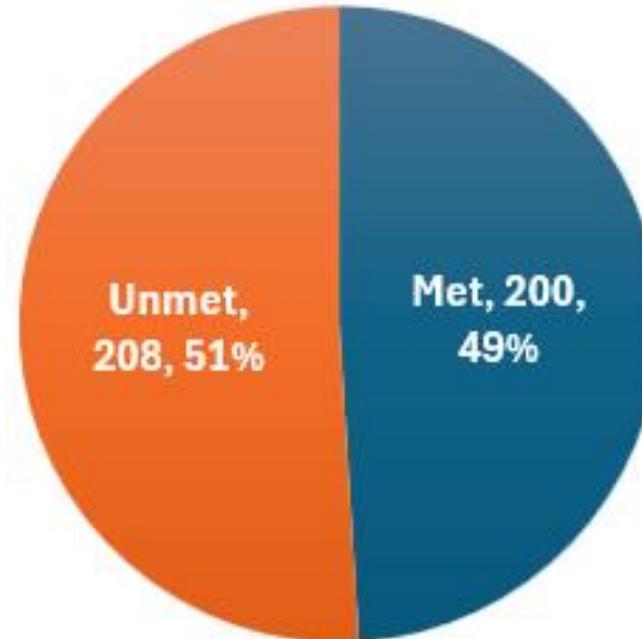

Finalized/Finalization- The Final Section is the last document of the incident report that the provider is required to complete. Once all information has been entered into the Final Section document the user must click the “Submit” button for the incident status to change to “Submitted”. This action is referred to as **Finalization**.

Closed- When an ODP management reviewer approves the Final Section of an incident report, the incident status changes to “Closed”. Only ODP can Close an incident.

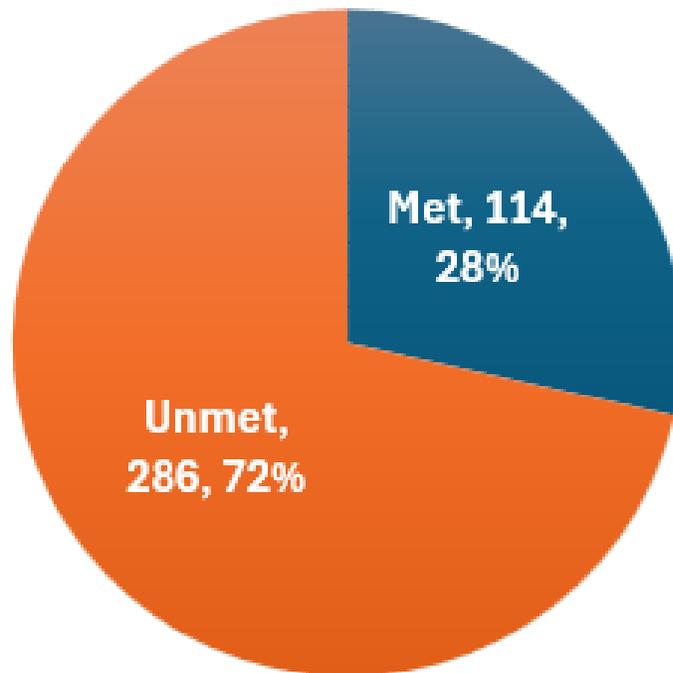

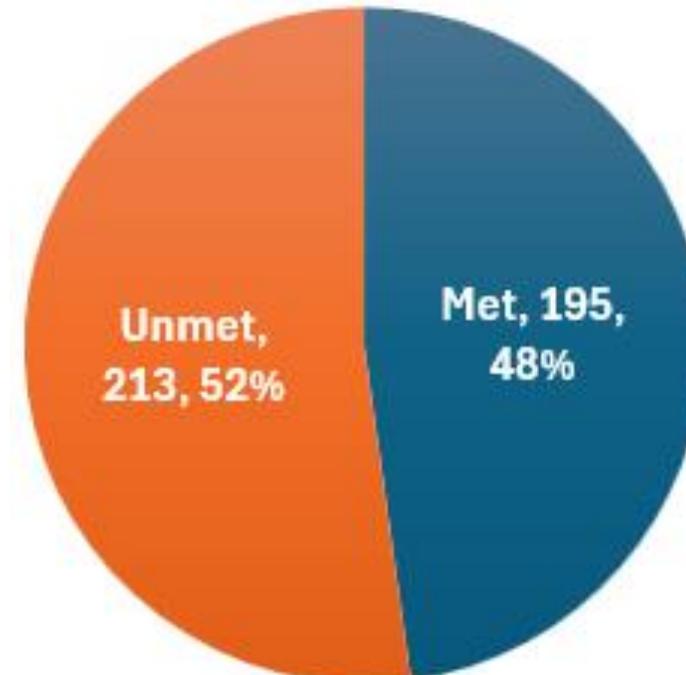


Timely finalization of incidents demonstrated by at least 86% of incidents finalized within 30 days of discovery

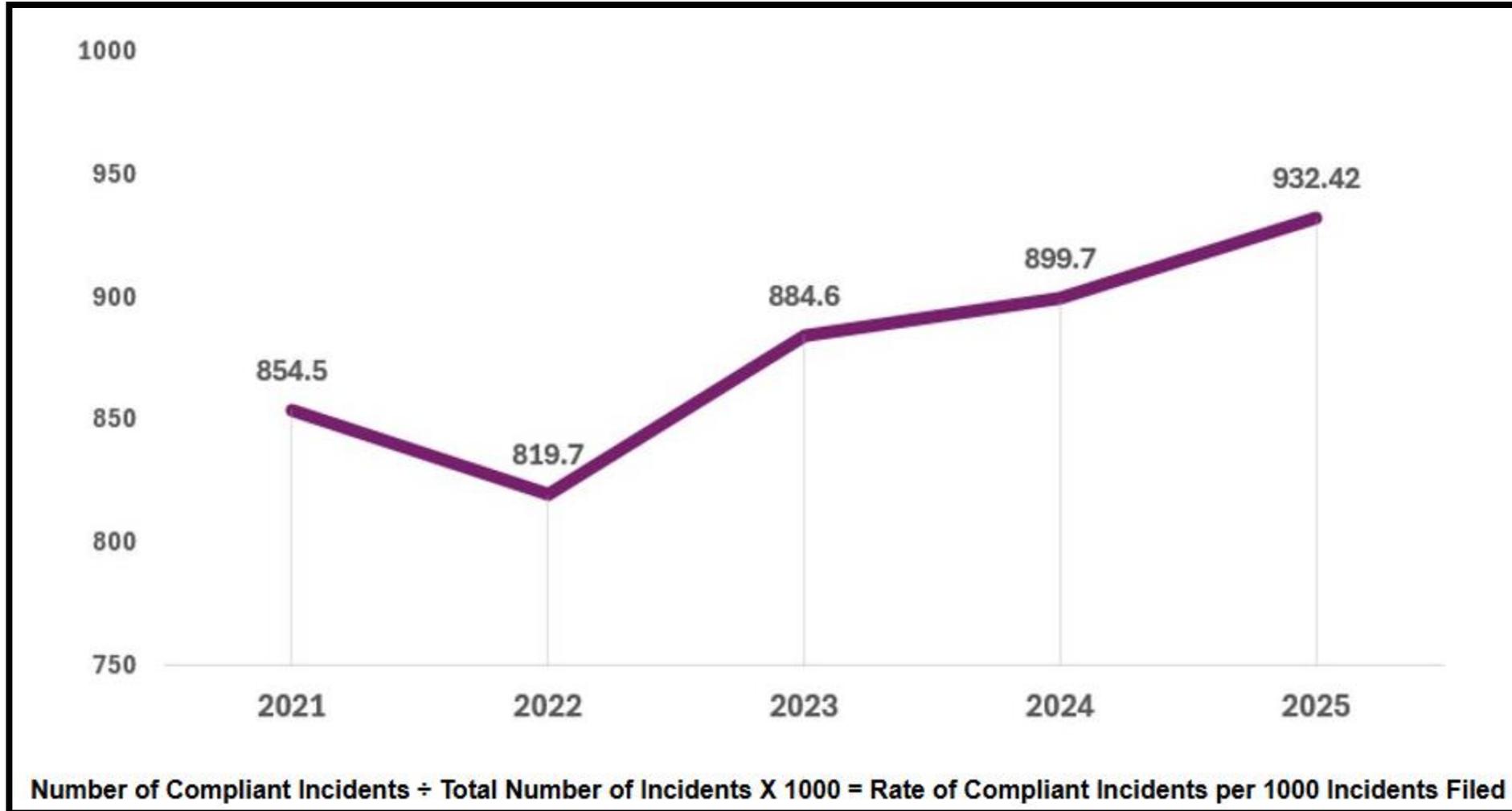
Timely finalization of incidents is demonstrated by: At least 95% of all incidents must be finalized by the due date, and the due date may only exceed 30 days in no more than 5% of those incidents (due dates may exceed 30 days when the provider has notified the Department in writing that an extension is necessary and the reason for the extension)

- PBC
 - Residential Data Submission ends **3/16/26 at 11:59pm**
 - Determination Letters will be sent end of April to mid-May (all will be sent on the same day)
 - For those submitting for Select or CE, the Resolution Process submission window will be 14 calendar days after letters are sent
 - Final Determination Letters will be sent in June
- P4P
 - Milestone 2 CIE Final Determination Letters expected **3/16/26**
 - Payment for Technology and Credentialing anticipated by end of April; CIE by end of May. Payment for P4P expected to be separated from regular service payment.
 - 26-27 P4P – Rural Capacity
- Next Residential Provider Forum is scheduled on **6/10/26**
